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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By participating in the EOI process, participants acknowledge and accept the following terms and conditions.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) SUBMISSIONS

- 1. EOI submissions must be submitted using the Oxford and Foley online form by 12 noon AEST on Monday 11 July 2022.
- 2. All EOI submissions must be made at the artist's own cost.

SHORTLISTING AND SELECTION

- 3. The Developer's representative will select 3-5 artists for Stage 2 design and budget development
- 4. The Developer reserves the right to shortlist and/or select Artworks/Projects in part or in full.
- 5. All decisions made by the Developer in relation to the EOI process are final
- 6. The shortlisting and/or selection of any Artwork/Project will be at the sole discretion of the Developer. Shortlisting is no guarantee of selection.
- 7. Stage Two submissions for shortlisted Artworks/Projects must be submitted in accordance with the instructions specified by the Developer.
- Artists must be available for Stage Two development between 13 27 July 2022 to refine concept design, develop installation and maintenance plan for artwork, secure engineering certificates and insurances.
- 9. Shortlisted artists must consider any feedback or directions in relation to the proposed Artwork/Project provided by the Developer in response to their Stage One submission, and as part of preparing their Stage Two submission.
- 10. The Developer will pay \$1,000 (excluding GST) on receipt of a complete and conforming Stage Two Submission by the Key Date specified by the Developer, and a valid tax invoice. This is the maximum amount payable for a Stage Two Submission, irrespective of the number of Artworks/Projects and artists it comprises.
- 11. The Developer reserves the right to not proceed with any Artworks/Projects submitted via the EOI process, and/or to source Artworks/Projects outside the EOI process.
- 12. Shortlisting and/or acceptance of Artworks/Projects may be subject to an interview process.
- 13. The successful completion of a Stage 2 submission is no guarantee of selection or the Developer proceeding with the Artwork/Project.
- 14. The Developer reserves the right to consider Artworks/Projects for presentation dates beyond February 2023 subject to the agreement of both parties

AGREEMENT

15. Selected artists must enter into a commissioning agreement with the Developer for the delivery of the Artwork/Project. The terms governing the agreement will be provided to all shortlisted artists as part of Stage Two.

GENERAL

- 16. Selected Artworks/Projects must be installed in alignment with the Construction plans for the development, approximately February 2023.
- 17. Artists and participants in the EOI process must comply with all directions given by the Developer in relation to the EOI process.
- 18. Artists must comply with all NSW Government Public Health Orders in relation to the Artwork/Project and must comply with any direction in relation to complying with a Public Health Order given by the Developer or an authorised representative of the Developer.
- 19. Both the Developer and the artist must agree on the manner in which the Artwork/Project will be presented and attributed in any launch or publication material including and without limitation to any acknowledgments connected to the Artwork/Project.
- 20. Artists must not make any statements to the media about the EOI process and/or the Artwork/Project without prior approval from the Developer.
- 21. Artists will be responsible for obtaining public liability insurance (minimum of \$20 million per occurrence), professional indemnity insurance (where relevant), and worker's compensation insurance as required by law. Shortlisted artists must provide the Developer with certificates of currency for all required insurances.
